### Agenda Item No. 6: To brief on ongoing NAAC A&A progress till date

Dr. S.R. Patil, Dean – IQAC, informed that IIQA has been approved on 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2021. NAAC SSR (Self Study Report) has been submitted on 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2022. He added that Data Verification & Validation (DVV) process was initiated on 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. He informed that total 14 extended profile metrics and 59 criteria metrics were raised for DVV clarifications which were submitted on 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2022. He confirmed that Peer Team Visit of NAAC will be likely in the month of May/June.

### Agenda Item No. 7: To inform about Academic Audit of SUK for AY 2020-21

Dr. S. R. Patil, Dean – IQAC, informed that a committee of external members, Dr. A.C. Bhagali (Sanjay Bhokare group of Institute, Miraj) & Mr. J.B.
