Agenda 3: MIC Driven (20 % Weightage) & Self Driven activities (30 % Weightage)

Resolution: Apart from IIC Calendar Driven activities departments along with CIIED must keep check on MIC driven activities from time to time. Departments should plan self-driven activities and submit the plan well in advance to CIIED as per the quarters defined.

MIC Driven Activities: These activities are monthly planned and prescribed activities by IIC of MIC for IIC institutions to take part. MIC and AICTE in collaboration with other ministries and govt. and non-govt. agencies float various programs for students and faculties of IIC institutions to participate. Moreover, it also invites national and world leaders to address and inspire IIC institutions and these activities fall under the MIC driven activity category. These activities help IIC institutions to get a national platform to take part in various initiatives of

the central government and first-hand information with collaboration opportunities. This category carries a 10% weightage total. There is no minimum or maximum number of activities under this category. Those IIC institutes that take part in all announced MIC driven activities will get maximum weightage benefits.

Self-Driven Activities: These activities are planned and organized by IIC institutions based on their capability and competency to mobilize resources and collaboration with other agencies to promote innovation and entrepreneurship in their respective campuses. These included both basic and advanced nature of activities ensure streamlining and strengthening the innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem in HEIs.
